**IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT GDPR** In order to comply with the recent General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) which now apply in the UK, we are having to make some changes to the weekly parish newsletter which is distributed in our churches and posted on the parish website. These changes affect names to be included in the list of those who are sick and in any Mass Intentions for living persons:

Sick List GDPR requires that the individuals whose names appear on the sick list have given their consent to their names appearing there. So, in future, the only names that can be displayed on the sick list are the names of those individuals who have explicitly given their consent. N.B. in the case of a minor, a parent/guardian should give consent and in the case of adults who are unable to make decisions for themselves, a close relative or someone who has a health and welfare lasting power of attorney should do so. Consent forms for the names of those to be included on the sick list are available at the back of each church and/or on the parish website www.theparish.org.uk - please return the forms via the Sunday collection baskets or by email to stmarysphilip@aol.co.uk

The Parish Mass Intention Envelopes which are available in each church have a consent form to sign on the back of each envelope – please complete this if the Mass intention is for a living person whose name will appear in the newsletter/on the parish website.

# Gospel

Luke 3:10-18

The Lord be with you.

And with your spirit.

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Luke.

Glory to you, O Lord.

When all the people asked John, 'What must we do?' he answered, 'if anyone has two tunics he must share with the man who has none, and the one with something to eat must do the same.' There were tax collectors too who came for baptism, and these said to him, 'Master what must we do?' He said to them, 'Exact no more than your rate.' Some soldiers asked him in their turn, 'What about us? What must we do?' He said to them, 'No intimidation! No extortion! Be content with your pay!'

A feeling of expectancy had grown among the people, who were beginning to think that John might be the Christ, so John declared before them all, 'I baptise you with water, but someone is coming, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to undo the strap of his sandals; he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing-fan is in his hand to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his barn; but the chaff he will burn in a fire that will never go out.' As well as this, there were many other things he said to exhort the people and to announce the Good News to them.
