SUMMER OPENING AT USHAW COLLEGE DURHAM

The ancient chasuble worn by Cardinal Vincent Nichols during the Requiem Mass for the repose of the soul of King Richard III is to be put on public display at Ushaw College. The public will have the opportunity to view the "Westminster Vestment", which is part of the former Catholic seminary's heritage collection, over five Saturday's starting on April 4th between 12noon and 5.00pm. The display marks the first of the college's "Open Saturday's" which will run from April until August and which will give the public unprecedented access to beautiful and historic chapels, gardens and some parts of the buildings. There is a tradition that the chasuble was worn by the Benedictine monks of Westminster Abbey during the reign of King Richard and it is widely believed that the last Plantagenet monarch would have seen it when he attended Mass there. <u>CELEBRATION OF MARRIAGE</u> Bishop Seamus will celebrate Mass in St Mary's Cathedral on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> May at 11.00am to give thanks for the Sacrament of Marriage.
