



Update from the FTiH meeting held on Wednesday 16 November at St. Joseph's, Gateshead

Our church cluster reps, and some of our parishioners, attended this meeting, along with all the Gateshead churches proposed on last week's voting form. The general consensus in the hall was that the proposal of choice should be Proposal 1 - this was the least favoured proposal voted for last week by our cluster churches (only 27 parishioners out of a total 298 voters made this choice). Following some general disagreement, discussions and suggestions from around the hall our reps, and parishioners present, made the decision that we couldn't complete a partnership form with this grouping, as we didn't have a mandate from the parishioners. Therefore, those present unanimously decided that our three churches, plus Sacred Heart, Byermoor, will complete our own partnership form giving detailed information regarding all processes undertaken, plus timeline of talks and meetings with all the other churches in the area. Hopefully this information will aid Bishop Seamus and his council in their ultimate decisions.
