

CANCELLATION OF HCPT LOURDES PILGRIMAGE With profound regret the decision has been taken by HCPT's board of trustees that HCPT will not be proceeding with its 2020 Easter Pilgrimage to Lourdes. This decision was taken after a detailed evaluation of the situation surrounding the evolving COVID 19 epidemic, and consideration of likely trends over the next few months. Particular account was also taken of announcements made last week by French authorities with regard to the risks of gathering in large numbers and also concerns about the potential risk of any requirement for a period of isolation in France should an outbreak of the virus occur in the Lourdes area. The members of HCPT Group 41 would like to offer our heartfelt thanks to all those in our parish who have contributed to our fundraising efforts this year and give the reassurance that all donations made towards the cost of the 2020 Pilgrimage will now be carried forward towards the cost of our 2021 Pilgrimage instead.
